The family would also spent time at Mungkarta, Jalyirra and also at Greenwood Station, here she grew up and worked as a cleaner and Station hand, she was also a great Stockwoman, for this she was well known.

She also had a love for such animals as goats, donkey's and horses in the camp and station and also drove and mustered cattle. It was through this time she met her partner and then settled and lived closely to her parents and extended families, sadly her parents passed along with her partner in the mid- 80's, this led her to live with her Warupuntju sister at Ngurrutiji.

Year later she moved to Tennant Creek and lived with other families. She was always happy and would greet families with a big smile. Leaving us unexpected we will be missing her, but we'll never forget the character she was.
